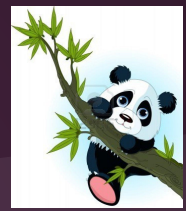

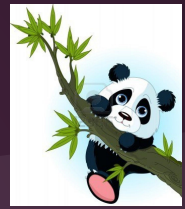
Home Connection: I will assign homework 3-4 times each week.
